A category is created when min. 4 participants. 4. In the event of fewer entries in a category, the competitor will automatically be moved to another category. 5. If it is not possible to move to another category and at least 3 players apply, half of the ranking points due shall be credited. If it is not possible to move to another category and at least 3 players have entered, half of the ranking points due will be credited. 6. Participants of the competition are obliged to present in the competition office, signed statements required by the Organiser (forms can be downloaded at www.ckis.pl or in the competition office)
